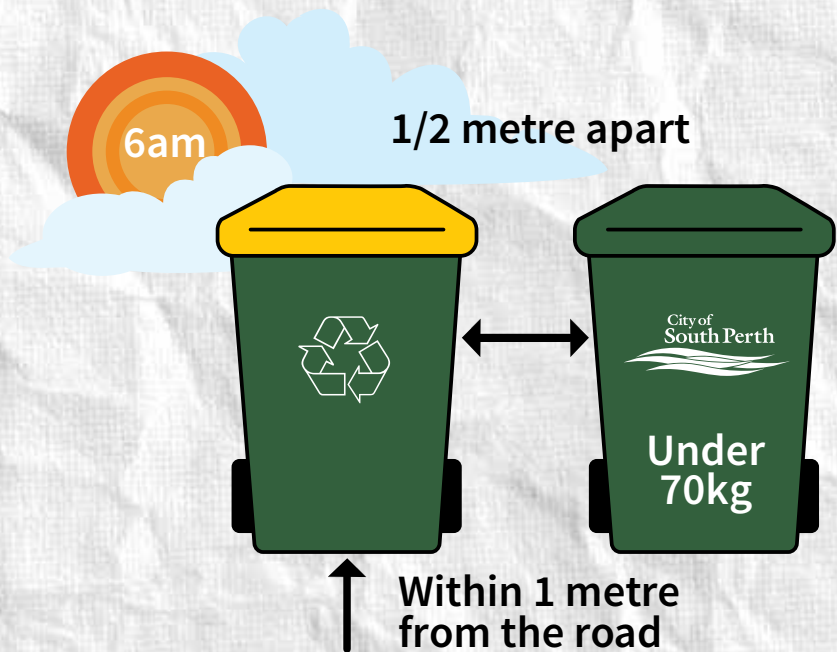

PUTTING MY BINS OUT FOR COLLECTION >

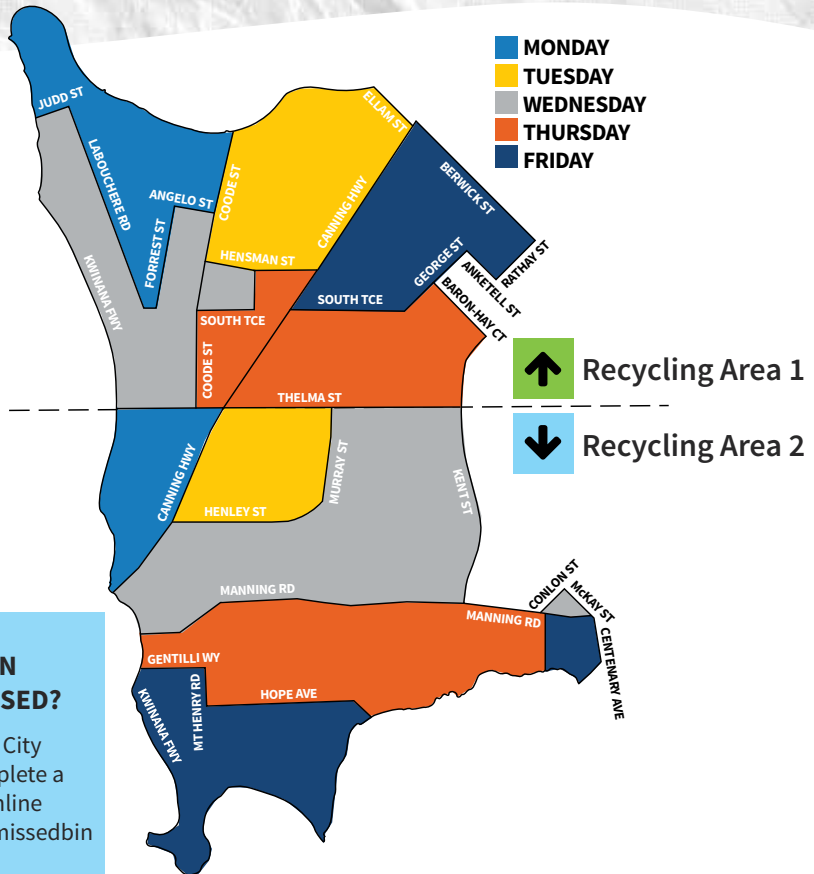
Please place your bins on the verge by 6am on the day of collection. Bins should be within one metre of the kerb with the wheels facing your house. Bin lids should be fully closed to prevent unwanted pests.

Your green lid and yellow lid recycling bins should be 50cm apart from each other. This is to ensure that the hydraulic arm on the collection vehicle is able to reach, lift and empty your bins. Please ensure that your bins are clear from any obstructions such as power poles, street trees, parked cars, signs, etc.



KERB SIDE BIN COLLECTION DAYS >

Your green lid bin is collected weekly and your yellow lid recycling bin is collected fortnightly. Please refer to the map below for your bin collection day.

WHAT CAN I PUT IN MY BINS? >



GREEN LID BIN

To help you get the most out of your rubbish collection service, store your bin in a shaded area, clean your bin regularly using hot soapy water and wrap all moist and perishable foods in newspaper, particularly in the summer months.

What **can** I place in my green lid bin?

- Food waste
- Garden waste; grass clippings, small branches, leaf litter and weeds
- General household waste; ceramics, clothing, plastic utensils and plates
- Sanitary products
- Doggie bags / nappies.



What **can't** I place in my green lid bin?

- Glass of any sort
- Hot ashes or coals
- Hazardous waste; petrol, flammable liquids, paints, solvents, batteries, chemicals or poisons
- All building materials; bricks, sand, concrete, tiles, rocks or asbestos.



YELLOW LID RECYCLING BIN

All recyclables should be clean before putting them in the bin and all food and liquid should be removed. Everything should be loose and not in plastic bags.

What **can** I place in my yellow lid bin?

- Glass bottles and jars (no lids)
- Plastic bottles and containers (no lids)
- Cardboard, paper, newspaper, office paper, magazines (no shredded paper)
- Drink cartons including fruit juice and milk cartons (no silver-lined UHT cartons)
- Steel and aluminium cans.



What **can't** I place in my yellow lid bin?

- China, porcelain or pottery
- Garden refuse
- Liquids and household food materials
- Polystyrene containers and meat trays
- Plastic bags and cling wrap
- Textiles
- Nappies
- Aerosols
- Lids of any sort.

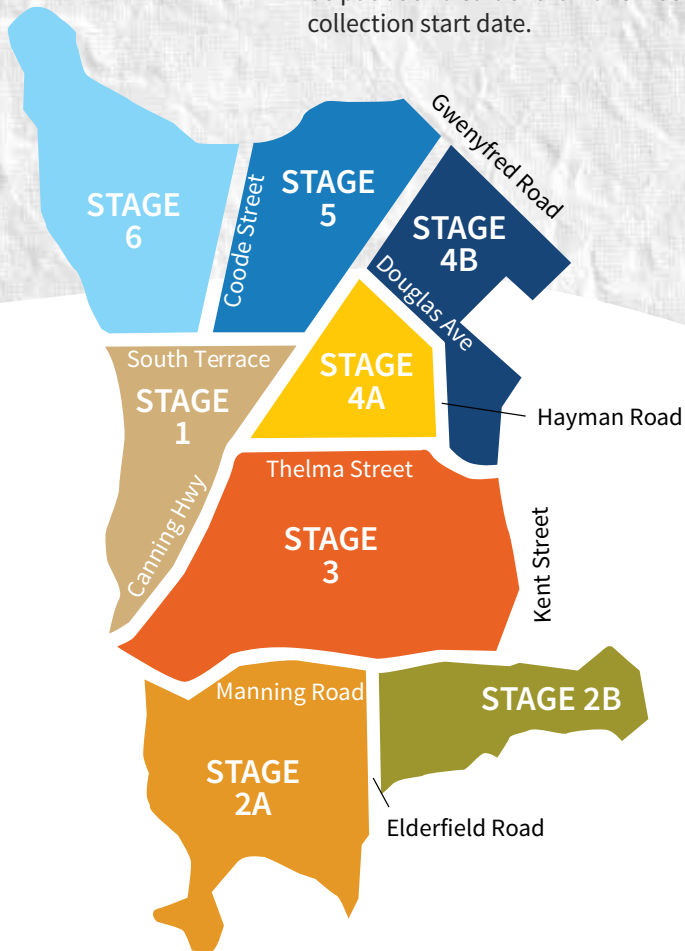

VERGE SIDE WASTE COLLECTIONS >

The City of South Perth provides one hard waste and two green waste verge side collections per year.

Items for the green and hard waste verge collection must be placed neatly on the verge by 7am on the scheduled start date for your area (including public holidays). Waste should be put out no earlier than one week before the collection start date.

GREEN WASTE COLLECTION >

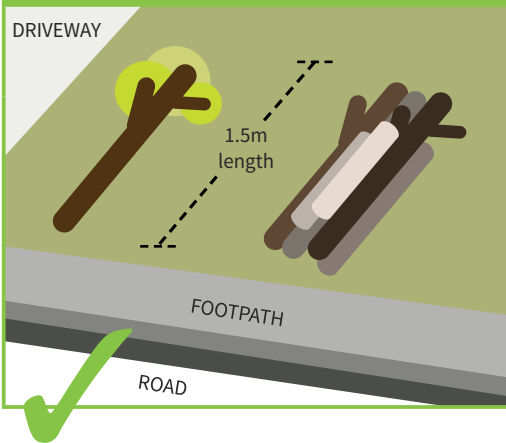
The City WILL collect:

- Uncontaminated green/garden waste
- Tree branches/prunings - maximum diameter 150mm and maximum length 1.5m
- Maximum 3 cubic metres per premise.

The City WILL NOT collect:

- General junk, building or household waste
- Tree trunks and stumps larger than 150mm in diameter or 1.5m in length
- Dug out lawn
- Green waste that is contaminated by household rubbish
- Lawn clippings and leaves (these may be placed in your regular bin and will be collected along with your weekly domestic rubbish collection).

Correctly set out green waste



Plastic bags and boxes of leaves, weeds, soil and lawn clippings WILL NOT be collected



If the green waste you set out for collection does not comply, it will not be collected.

The City does not have arrangements with commercial tree loppers or contractors. If you choose to use the services of a commercial contractor, it is your responsibility to ensure they comply with collection guidelines.

HARD WASTE COLLECTION >

The City WILL collect:

- Household furniture
- Whitegoods (stoves, dishwashers, washing machines, clothes dryers, etc)
- Fridges and freezers (doors must be removed)
- Air conditioners
- General junk, small electrical goods, carpet, linoleum, mattresses and metal items no longer than 1.5m
- Unwanted pine (untreated pine materials, firewood, logs, timber, furniture, etc)
- e-Waste items such as computers and televisions
- Maximum 4 cubic metres per premise.

The City WILL NOT collect:

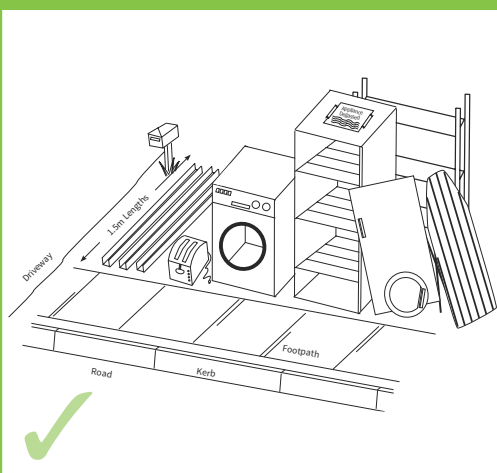
- Bricks, rubble, sand, cement and other building waste
- Asbestos cement products
- Household hazardous waste (oil, pesticides, solvents, chemicals, paint, etc)
- Tyres, batteries, motor vehicles (whole or parts of)
- Household waste
- Gas cylinders
- Any plate glass such as windows, shower screens or outdoor tables
- Items longer than 1.5m (roller doors, metal poles, timber, etc)
- Trampolines unless disassembled
- Green waste or lawn.

Please assist us by placing hard waste on your own verge and into separate piles:

- Metals/whitegoods
- Mattresses
- e-Waste
- General waste.

To ensure the maximum amount of waste is recycled different trucks are allocated to specific items. Waste left behind after the collection is your responsibility and must be removed from the verge within seven days, or \$200-\$500 litter infringements will be issued.

City of South Perth residents and property owners can dispose of additional waste and recycling at the City's Recycling Centre.

For more information on the items you can drop at the Recycling Centre and the associated fees, please visit the City's website southperth.wa.gov.au/waste.

Pre-separating your waste will assist in the unloading and recycling process.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Monday to Sunday, 9am–4.45pm

Closed Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day, Good Friday, ANZAC Day, WA Day and other days as required by the City of South Perth.

ENTRY VOUCHERS

As part of the annual rubbish levy, ratepayers receive three entry vouchers for the Recycling Centre. These are sent out at the beginning of each financial year enclosed with the rates notices.

FREE RECYCLING

To assist the City of South Perth in reducing waste to landfill and increasing recycling, the following items are accepted free of charge:

- E-Waste
- Clean and uncontaminated cardboard
- Uncontaminated used motor oil
- All scrap metal including fridges, washing machines and microwaves
- Fluorescent lighting tubes and globes
- Household and vehicle batteries.

FREE MULCH

City of South Perth residents can collect free mulch from the City's Recycling Centre. If you wish to take mulch, you must load it yourself from the pile provided at the Recycling Centre.

ASBESTOS DISPOSAL DAY

10am-2pm, Saturday 26 October 2019

Asbestos must be double wrapped in industrial thick black plastic (min 200um) and securely gaffer taped.

There is a maximum of 3 fence sheets per household.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Household hazardous waste (HHW) includes flammable liquids, petrol, paints, acids, chemicals, poisons and gas cylinders. You can safely dispose of domestic quantities of HHW at the Canning Waste Transfer Station or the Armadale Landfill and Recycling Facility. For more information, visit www.wasteauthority.wa.gov.au
