HOW TO NOMINATE

The City of South Perth is aware of the vital role volunteer's play in our community and the need to recognise and celebrate their efforts.

The City is proud to present the fifteenth annual City of South Perth Volunteer of the Year Awards. These Awards aim to distinguish three volunteers for their individual efforts within our community.

Award Categories

There are three categories of awards:

- Junior Volunteer - 18 years and under
- Youth Volunteer - 18 to 25 years
- Volunteer of the Year - over 25 years

Who can be nominated

- Individuals who live, or whose volunteering is based, in the City of South Perth and who contribute significantly to the local community.

Who can't be nominated

- City of South Perth employees
- Members of the selection panel and their immediate families
- Serving members of the City of South Perth Council.

Award Criteria

The Awards will be conveyed upon individuals who have:

- had noteworthy involvement in the local community
- made significant impact which has added value to community life
- made inspiring efforts to enhance community life.

All nominees will be invited to attend the City's Awards Ceremony on Thursday 2 December 2021. Award nominees will receive a certificate signed by the Mayor and the winners from each category will receive an engraved plaque.
