Public Computer, Internet and Online Services Conditions of Use

- 1. Public Computers will be available in City of South Perth Libraries (Library) from the time of opening until 5 minutes before closure.
- 2. Library Members may access Public Computers providing their library account is free from outstanding fees and charges.
- 3. Guest passes for Public Computers may be purchased for a fee by persons who do not fulfil Library Membership Terms and Conditions requirements. A time limit will be applied for each guest session.
- 4. A maximum continuous usage may be applied to allow equity of access during busy periods.
- 5. Public computer users may print information for a fee.
- 6. A limit of two persons only can use a public computer at any one time.
- 7. Children under 12 years of age must have parental supervision to use the public computers.
- 8. Users are not permitted to modify the installed hardware or software in any way. Users who disregard this will be prohibited from using the service.
- 9. Access to the Internet is available for the purpose of researching electronic information resources.
- 10. Internet Users must abide by the WA Classification (Publications, Film and Computer Games) Enforcement Act 1996, which bans the use of the Internet to transmit restricted material to a minor or to make restricted material available to a minor.
- 11. Internet Users must not knowingly access sites containing objectionable material under the WA Classification (Publications, Film and Computer Games) Enforcement Act 1996 and users who disregard this will be prohibited from using the service.
- 12. A copy of the WA Classification (Publications, Film and Computer Games) Enforcement Act 1996 is available on request.
- 13. Internet and Public PC Users must not intimidate, insult or cause emotional harm to others online and must abide by Library eSafety behaviours.
