

2025 CHRISTMAS LIGHTS COMPETITIONTerms & Conditions

Competition

The 'Christmas Lights Competition' (the Competition) is a competition run by the City of South Perth only and is subject to these terms and conditions (Terms).

Eligibility

- 1. To be eligible to enter the Competition, the entrant must be 18 years of age or over and a registered owner and/or occupier of a residential property or business in the City of South Perth prior to the commencement of the Competition (Eligible Participant).
- 2. The Competition is a promotion run by the City of South Perth and is open to all residents and businesses within the City, with the exception of Elected Members and City staff who are <u>not</u> eligible to enter.
- 3. Where a property is located in a strata title, it is the responsibility of the Eligible Participant to ensure that no body corporate, strata by-laws or the like are applicable that would inhibit or restrict participation in the Competition.

Competition Period

- 1. The Registration Period commences at 9:00am AWST on Monday, 3 November 2025 and ends at 11:59pm AWST on Sunday, 30 November 2025 (**Registration Period**). The Competition Period commences at 9:00am AWST on Monday, 1 December 2025 and ends at 11.59pm AWST on Wednesday 24 December 2025 (**Competition Period**).
- 2. Light displays are to be on during the Competition Period, with judging to occur between the hours of 8:00pm AWST and 11:00pm AWST between Monday 8 December 2025 and Friday 12 December 2025 (Judging Period).
- 3. Any locations where the lights are not switched on during the Judging Period will not be considered.

Entry/Registration

- 1. Entry to the competition is via the online form on the City of South Perth website only. Entries submitted via email will not be accepted.
- 2. There is no cost to enter.

- 3. Eligible Participants are responsible for all costs associated with their display.
- 4. By entering the competition, Eligible Participants consent to the address of the display being publicly communicated on the City's website and advertising material. This may include a photograph of the property/light display and, if the display wins the relevant category, a photograph of the Eligible Participant with the Mayor, Ward Councillor/s, CEO and/or category sponsor/s in front of the display.
- 5. The Eligible Participants acknowledge that their email address will only be used for communication purposes in relation to the Competition.

Prize Categories

- 1. Best Business Shopfront
 - a) Only <u>one</u> application will be accepted per business for this individual category.
 - b) The winner is selected by a Judging Panel; the panel decision is final.
- 2. Best Residential
 - a) Only one application will be accepted per household for this individual category.
 - b) The winner is selected by a Judging Panel; the panel decision is final.

Voting

- 1. Voting will be by a Judging Panel only, who will determine the winners of the two prize categories.
- 2. The Judging Panel will consist of at least two judges including the Mayor and Chief Executive Officer (CEO), or suitable representative.

Safety

- 1. It is the Eligible Participants responsibility to ensure their lights display is electrically and structurally safe.
- 2. The City of South Perth will not be held liable for any loss, damage, theft or for any personal injury sustained as a result of participating in the competition, including during the installation or removal of displays.

Prize and Announcement of Winners

- 1. A total of two prizes will be awarded as specified below.
 - a) Best Business Shopfront \$1,000
 - b) Best Residential \$3,000
- 2. The prizes are not transferable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash.
- 3. Winners will be announced via the City's website and social media channels. Winners will be notified via the contact details provided in their entry form.
- 4. Winners will be contacted to arrange a suitable time in the week beginning Monday 15 December 2025 for a photo opportunity with the Mayor, Ward Councillor/s, CEO and sponsor/s at the display and to receive their prize.
