

Beanies Made With Love

Beanies for the Homeless in Perth

Beanie Pattern

Please make the beanie long so it can be pulled over the ears

2 to 3 balls 8 ply wool – size 3 & size 4 needles.

With size 3 needles cast 90 Stitches.

RIB: knit 2 purl 2 until rib band measures 8cms.

Change to size 4 needles and knit in stocking stitch

(1 row knit, 1 row purl) for a further 16cms.

Work now measures 24cms.

Then on next knit row: knit 8, knit 2 together, repeat until end of the row.

On next purl row and all purl rows just purl, don't decrease.

On next knit row: knit 7, knit 2 together.

Next knit row: knit 6, knit 2 together etc.

Repeat, decreasing on knit row only until you have knit 1 knit 2 together.

Snip off approximately 20cm length of wool, thread wool in needle, gather stitches, fold work and sew seam.
