
Pipes for Perth



Dear customer,

As you are likely aware, Water Corporation has been replacing a water main along Mill Point Road in South Perth.

While this work will cause some temporary inconvenience, it will improve the security and reliability of the water supply to your property.

Upcoming night works starting Sunday 23rd July 2017

We will be undertaking night work in the intersection of Mill Point Road and Mends Street from Sunday night 23rd July to Thursday night 27th July between 7pm and 6am.

During the night work, we will be installing the new main at this intersection via underground drilling. The work will take place along the southern side of Mill Point Road, across the intersection and along the eastern side of Mends Street. We will be excavating pits to drill and install the new main. All open excavations will be enclosed by 1.8m temporary fencing for the duration of the works. Excavations in the roadways or in close proximity to the intersection will be suitably backfilled. Undertaking this work at night lessens the impact on the high volume of traffic that passes through this intersection.

Sunday night 23rd July: Drill Shot 1 – Eastwards along Mill point Road, across Mends Street.

Monday night 24th July: Drill Shot 2 – Southwards along Mends Street, across Mill Point Road.

Tuesday night 25th July: Drill Shot 3 – Northwards along Mends Street towards Mill Point Road.

Wednesday night 26th July: Drill Shot 4 – From Harper Terrace Eastwards along Mill Point Road.


Thursday night 27th July: Completion and connections at installed pipe intersections.

Work in this section of Mill Point Road is expected to be finished by mid-august 2017.

Property access

Access to your business and property will be available at all times during these works, although there may be some minor delays if we are completing the section directly out the front of your property. Where possible works are staged during off peak days to minimise disruption to your business and patrons. If your driveway is restricted at any time and you need to enter or exit your property, please speak to one of our friendly onsite crew, who will be happy to assist.

Why we are doing this work

Many of Perth's first water mains were laid from the 1890s onwards and are still in use today, but are starting to show wear and tear. That's why we have developed a renewals program to proactively replace over 150km of these original water mains in Perth by the end of 2018.

Our process

Water Corporation uses contractors to complete all construction work. When our contractor first arrives to a site, they need to locate all underground services, such as gas, power, telecommunication cables and existing water connections. This must be completed to confirm the planned alignment of the new main is suitable, and that excavation work can be undertaken safely. This process can take several days.

The contractor also needs to do other preliminary site preparation, such as arranging safety fencing, signage and lay-down areas for equipment. As a result it can appear to passers-by that not much construction work is happening onsite for the first week or so. Please be assured that this site preparation is reflective of a standard work schedule.

Reinstatement of verges and driveways

Please be assured that any affected area will be re-instated to its original condition as closely as possible. Where we can, we will work with you to accommodate requests you may have regarding reinstatement of affected areas, such as your driveway or verge.

Traffic management


Traffic management will be in place around the intersection to ensure the safety of pedestrians, road users and our workers. Detours and signage will guide drivers and pedestrians to appropriate routes.

Noise

We will try to undertake noisier work earlier at night to minimise disruption to local residents in the area.
