Green Waste Collection 13 April to 22 May 2015

No hard waste will be collected.

STAGE I: 13 April, Como Beach

STAGE 2: 20 April, Manning, Salter Point, Waterford

STAGE 3: 27 April, Como, Manning, Karawara

STAGE 4: 4 May, Como, Kensington

STAGE 5: 11 May, South Perth

STAGE 6: 18 May, South Perth

We will collect:

- Uncontaminated green/garden waste
- Tree prunings/branches with a maximum diameter of 150m
- Maximum 3 cubic metres per premise

We won't collect:

- Lawn clippings and leaves. These may be placed in your regular bin and will be collected along with your weekly domestic rubbish collection
- General junk, building or household waste
- Tree trunks and stumps larger than 150mm in diameter or 1.5m in length
- Dug out lawn
- Green waste that is contaminated by household rubbish
