Winter Broadleaf Spraying of Weeds

Herbicide spraying will be carried out on turf areas of the parks, reserves and around buildings throughout the City of South Perth (21 June until 29 July 2016, subject to weather conditions) targeting broad leaf weeds and Bindii.

The turf registered selective herbicide "JOLT" will be used in accordance with the manufacturer's labelled directions and applied via boom sprayer on broad acre areas and smaller areas by hand spray. A foam indicator will be used in conjunction with the selective herbicide. The foam will remain visible for approximately 2-3 hours after application.

Appropriate signage will be displayed on the moving vehicle and in strategic locations whilst the work is being undertaken with the spraying operation being monitored by City of South Perth officers.
