## Works to begin on Millers Pool >



As part of the City's South Perth Foreshore Strategy and Management Plan, the Millers Pool project aims to improve amenity, access and natural features of the Mill Point foreshore.

Works at Millers Pool will commence in early September 2016 and includes upgraded picnic and seating areas, a new path network, planting of native vegetation and trees, carpark and road improvements, new lighting and public art.

The site working hours will generally be confined to 7am to 5pm, Monday to Saturday. Works are planned to take approximately 18 weeks and are scheduled to be completed by the end of 2016.

Access to the foreshore surrounding Millers Pool and car park 11 will be restricted to allow construction activities to be undertaken. Find out more about the Millers Pool project on the City's website.
