

City-wide Parking Strategy adopted by Council

At the Council Meeting held on Tuesday 24 May 2016, the Council adopted a Parking Strategy that will provide a long-term plan for the management and provision of parking within the City.

Luxmore Parking and Safety Consultants were commissioned by the City to develop the Strategy which will provide a parking framework for the next 15 years to assist in achieving, amongst other things, the City's goals in relation to travel demand management and sustainable modes of transport.

The strategy outlines 22 recommendations for review and implementation, identifying a comprehensive action plan to assist in the development of Management Plans for 14 Parking Control Areas (PCA) within the City including the South Perth Station Precinct.

Gone in less than 60 seconds

The City, in partnership with six other local governments and the WA Police South East Metropolitan Police District, is working to minimise theft from motor vehicles.

'Gone in less than 60 seconds' is a campaign designed to raise awareness of how quickly thefts from motor vehicles can occur, especially when valuable items like phones and bags are visible and unattended.

From 1 June until 1 December 2016, the City will be releasing a video on its Facebook each month to highlight the CCTV footage of real life thefts that have occurred in less than 60 seconds.

As part of the campaign, a clearly marked vehicle will be visiting local shopping centres, community events and

hot spot locations displaying a range of items that are commonly stolen from cars.

To help deter thieves, the City has free car window safety signs available from the Civic Centre and South Perth and Manning Libraries.

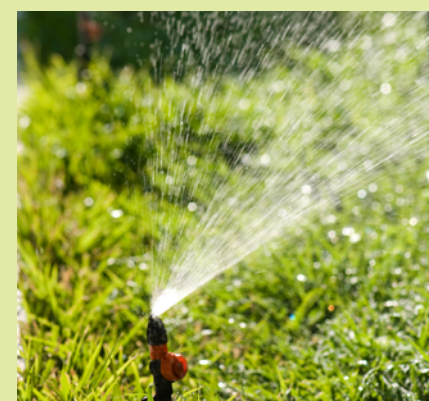
