## Free park 'n' ride to Perth Zoo >

Free parking and a shuttle bus service is available for residents and visitors to Perth Zoo for the duration of the September/October school holidays. The service is a joint initiative between the City and the Zoo.

An area of Sir James Mitchell Park immediately adjacent to Lamb Street, off Ellam Street in South Perth has been set aside for vehicle parking. A 35 seater shuttle bus will transport visitors between this location and Perth Zoo

every 20 minutes, between 10am to 5pm each day, ending Sunday 9 October 2016.

“This collaboration works towards improving parking outcomes in South Perth during this busy period,” Mayor Sue Doherty said.

“A gold coin donation can be made on the shuttle bus, with all contributions directed towards Perth Zoo’s Wildlife Conservation Action Fund to help save wildlife.”
