The City of South Perth's newly elected Council was determined on Saturday 21 October 2017.

The count of the votes commenced at 6pm at the City of South Perth Civic Centre, conducted by the City's Returning Officer.

Glenn Cridland was re-elected as Como ward Councillor for a term of four years.

Cheryle Irons was re-elected as Mill Point ward Councillor for a term of four years.

Three newly elected members took their place on Council:

- **Greg Milner** (Moresby ward for a term of four years)
- Tracie McDougall (Como ward for a term of two years)
- Blake D'Souza (Manning ward for a term of four years)

The newly elected Council were sworn in and a Deputy Mayor elected at a Special Council Meeting on Monday 23 October 2017.

The five Councillors, representing the City's four wards were sworn in at the special presentation in the City Council Chambers.
