# Strategic Community Plan released >

The City of South Perth has officially launched its new Strategic Community Plan 2017-2027, a guiding document for the City and community over the next 10 years.

The City will use the Plan to: define clear priorities, process, long and short-term plans; prioritise budget and resource allocations; direct land use, infrastructure, services and asset management, operations and planning; direct workforce planning and inform other key strategies and plans.

### Aquatic vegetation >

The City's Environmental Management team regularly monitor the City's lakes and waterbodies for the presence of aquatic weeds. Aquatic vegetation growth severity and frequency are mitigated by controlling the nutrient supply to the waterbody. Everyone can work toward reducing excess nutrients and pollution from entering waterbodies by:

- Picking up animal droppings
- Not feeding native wildlife
- Correctly disposing of unwanted garden waste
- Washing vehicles on the lawn and using phosphorus free detergents
- Using fertilisers in moderation and following the instructions carefully.
