Australia Day Parking & Traffic>

The Kwinana Freeway exit ramps (Northbound and Southbound) and the roads bounded by Labouchere Road, Angelo Street, Douglas Avenue, Canning Highway and Ellam Street in South Perth will be closed from 10am to 10.30pm on 26 January 2017. Entry into Way Road from Canning Highway will be closed from 8am.

No street, verge or crossover parking will be permitted during this time.

Residents or guests that ordinarily park on the road or verge (this includes your crossover), must observe the temporary parking signs. To find out if your street is affected please refer to the traffic and parking map on the City's website www.southperth.wa.gov.au/australiaday.

Australia Day resident street parking

To obtain a Resident Verge Permit you must reside in a single residential property (this does not apply to apartments and unit complexes) and your vehicle must be registered to your address. If your vehicle is not registered to your address (e.g. people driving a work car), please provide proof that links your vehicle to your address (e.g. letter from employer).

Free event transport>

To facilitate access to the Australia Day Celebration Zone, the City will be providing a free shuttle service between the George Burnett Leisure Centre (Manning Rd, Cnr Elderfield Rd, Karawara), the City of South Perth Civic Centre (Cnr Sandgate St and South Tce, South Perth) and the event zone.

The shuttle buses will run approximately every 10 minutes back and forth between 2-9.30pm, but not during the fireworks (7.30-8.30pm). Ample parking is available at the Civic Centre and the Leisure Centre.
