Mends Street Connect South is a \$7.5 million major project to enhance and invigorate the Mends Street precinct and foreshore area.

In October 2016, the City successfully secured \$2.5 million in Round 3 of the National Stronger Regions Fund (NSRF) adding to the City's contribution of \$5 million over two financial years. Mends Street Connect South is about creating a dynamic destination at this important

riverside location. It is envisaged to be a transport and commercial hub, where local businesses thrive and the diversity and rich history of the area are celebrated.

The City is undergoing a tender process and will shortly appoint a consultant to provide urban design and landscape services for stage one of the project. To find out more visit southperth.wa.gov.au/connectsouth.
