The City's Autumn green waste verge side collection will begin this week and will run until **8 May 2017**. Green waste should be placed on your verge no earlier than one week prior to collection. Lawn clippings and leaves will not be collected, these can be placed in your regular bin or recycled at the City's Recycling Centre.
